Such is the great need of our culture today. Women who would desire and fulfil their faithful roll before God. *“A woman of valor is the crown of her husband, but she who causes shame is like rottenness in his bones.”* (Proverbs 12:4.)

She who would meditate on the description of the wise or virtuous woman in Proverbs 31 will be blessed. How much stronger would marriages and homes be today if we, both husbands and wives, would not allow ourselves to be molded by the whims and customs of our culture, but by God’s design.

As our minds are attuned to the special days of the seasons such as Mother’s Day and Father’s Day, it serves as good reminders to think on what the Scriptures provide as examples and instructions as to our responsibilities before God; for it is to Him that we will have to give account. (2 Cor. 5:9,10)

The Apostles Paul and Peter gave practical as well as spiritual instruction for the role of women in their relationship to their husbands. (Eph. 5:22-24) *“Wives sub-*

mit to your own husbands, as to the Lord.” vs 24—Therefore, just as the church is subject to Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in everything.”

For the roles of women, both old and young, in the Lord’s church Paul instructed Timothy what to remind them of. (Titus 2:3-5). *“the older women likewise, that they be reverent in behavior, not slanderers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things—that they admonish the young women to love their husbands, to love their children, to be discreet, chaste, homemakers, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be blasphemed.”*

Finally, the Apostle Peter follows his teaching on the humility of Christ in chapter 2 with these words for Christian wives and the great eternal value of the faithful wife’s example before her unbelieving husband. What a wonderful potential! (1 Pet. 3:1-6) *“Likewise you wives, be submissive to your own husbands, that even if some do not obey the word, they, without a word, may be won by the conduct of their wives,, when they observe your chaste conduct accompanied by fear. Do not let your beauty be that outward adorning of arranging the hair, of wearing gold, or of putting on fine apparel; but let it be the hidden person of the heart, with the incorruptible ornament of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is very precious in the sight of God.”*

“Charm is deceitful and beauty is vain, but a woman who fears the Lord, she shall be praised.” (Proverbs 31:30)
